BUREAU HISTORY AND PURPOSE

HISTORY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT PSYCHOLOGY

- MORE THAN 50 YEARS AGO, FIRST PSYCHOLOGIST HIRED AS A FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE OF LAPD IN 1968.
- PROFESSION HAS BEEN REFERRED TO IN THE LITERATURE AS "POLICE PSYCHOLOGY", "LAW ENFORCEMENT PSYCHOLOGY", AND "PUBLIC SAFETY PSYCHOLOGY".
- LASD HAS EMPLOYED PSYCHOLOGISTS SINCE THE MID 1970'S TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO ITS SWORN AND CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES AND THEIR FAMILIES.

PURPOSE OF THE BUREAU

- FOCUS ON INCREASING THE HEALTH, WELL-BEING, AND PRODUCTIVITY OF THE ORGANIZATION AND ITS EMPLOYEES.
- COLLABORATIVELY DEVELOP INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS AND PROVIDE EMERGENT SERVICES WHEN NEEDED, 24/7.
- ACTIVELY ENGAGE IN CLINICAL PRACTICE, TRAINING, CONSULTATION, AND RESEARCH.

- FULL-SERVICE OUTPATIENT PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES PROGRAM FOR ALL DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES, SIGNIFICANT OTHERS, AND THEIR FAMILIES
- SERVICES ARE PROVIDED ON A ROUTINE AND EMERGENCY BASIS
- FOUR OFFICE LOCATIONS; OPERATES BETWEEN 0800-1700 MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY
- 24/7 EMERGENCY ON-CALL SERVICE
- CONNECTION TO AN ARRAY OF SPECIALIZED EXTERNAL SERVICE PROVIDÉRS

- POST APPROVED FIELD TRAINING OFFICER (FTO) TRAINING (SB 29), AND DEPUTY SHERIFF TRAINEE (DST) ACADEMY LD 37 (15 HOURS-SB 11)
- 32 HOUR DeVRT/CIT PROGRAM FOR CUSTODY AND FIELD OPERATIONS PERSONNEL (STO AND POST-APPROVED TRAINING)
- INDIVIDUALIZED CONSULTATION AND TRAINING FOR SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS, BUREAUS AND UNITS (e.g., SVB, HOMICIDE, PATROL, AND CUSTODY DIVISIONS)
