

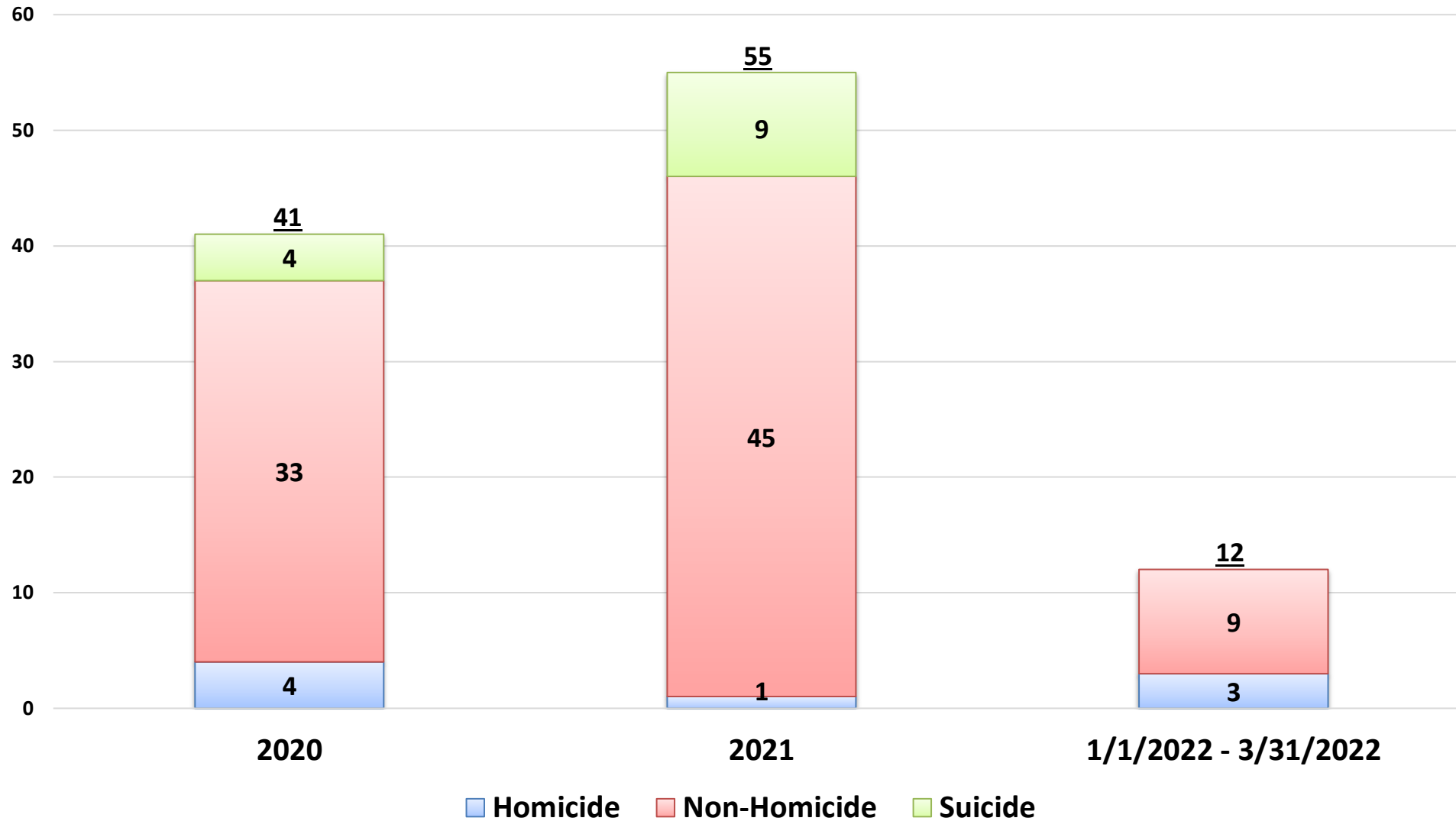

In-Custody Deaths by Year*



*The number of in-custody deaths the Office of Inspector General reports may vary slightly from data provided by the Sheriff's Department because the Sheriff's Department identifies in-custody deaths by custody status and the location of an individual's death. For instance, a death in the field during an arrest would be considered an in-custody death because of the person's custodial status even though the individual was not in a custodial facility. There were 3 in 2020, 5 in 2021, and 1 from January 1, 2022, to March 31, 2022.

Office of Inspector General Monitoring of In-Custody Deaths

- Respond to scenes of in-custody deaths
- Attend autopsies and review reports
- Attend all Administrative Death Reviews
- Make recommendations for corrective action or other systemic reform

Recurring Systemic Issues Identified by LASD and CHS During Critical Incident Reviews January 1, 2020, through March 31, 2022

- Medical and/or Mental Health Care
 - 25 deaths
- Custody/Security
 - 30 deaths
- Interdisciplinary Coordination
 - 11 deaths
