I presented the budget of 238.5 Billion to the LA Board of Supervisors on 9/10/2024 to be spent this year. Gov Gavin Newsom approved the "AI Accountability Act" 9/30/2024. In Nov of this year I identified institutional racism at the Pasadena Courthouse against Judge Joel Lofton an African American and active military using this technology and would like to request for permission to roll this out for the court and healthcare systems to detect racism and persecution by wealth under the executive orders from Newsom/Biden and Harris.
