

SUBJECT

Public Works is seeking Board approval to establish and adopt the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project; approve of an appropriation adjustment; and adopt, advertise, and award the construction contract for the proposed project that will be delivered using the County's competitive low bid process.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

- 1. Find the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act for the reasons stated in this Board letter and in the record of the project.
- 2. Establish and approve the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project, Capital Project No. 87914, with a total proposed project budget of \$1,064,000.
- 3. Approve an appropriation adjustment to transfer \$1,022,000 derived from Utility User Tax, Cy Pres II, funds from the Extraordinary Maintenance Budget to the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project, Capital Project No. 87914.
- Adopt the plans and specifications that are on file with Public Works for construction of the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project, Capital Project No. 87914.

- 5. Instruct the Executive Officer of the Board to advertise the proposed project for bids to be received and opened on February 14, 2023, in accordance with the Instruction Sheet for Publishing Legal Advertisements.
- 6. Authorize the Director of Public Works or his designee to execute a consultant services agreement with the apparent lowest responsive and responsible bidder to prepare a baseline construction schedule for a \$5,000 not-to-exceed amount funded by the proposed project funds.
- 7. Delegate authority to the Director of Public Works or his designee to make the determination that a bid is nonresponsive and to reject a bid on that basis; award the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder; waive inconsequential and nonmaterial deficiencies in bids submitted; and determine, in accordance with the applicable contract and bid documents, whether the apparent lowest responsive and responsible bidder timely prepared a satisfactory baseline construction schedule and satisfied all conditions for contract award. Upon such determination, authorize the Director of Public Works or his designee to award and execute the construction contract, in the form previously approved by County Counsel, to the apparent lowest responsive and responsible bidder if the low bid can be awarded within the approved total budget. Establish the effective date of the contract upon receipt by Public Works of acceptable performance and payment bonds, evidence of required contractor insurance, and to take all other actions necessary and appropriate to deliver the proposed project.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of the recommended actions will find the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); approve the proposed project, budget, and appropriation adjustment; adopt the plans and specifications; and authorize Public Works to advertise and award a construction contract for the proposed project.

Project Description and Background

Willowbrook Senior Center is located at 12915 Jarvis Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90061. The center provides opportunities for daily learning, skills enhancement, community engagement, socialization, and healthy living for residents of all ages. The deteriorated condition of the chain link fence and entry gate on Carlton Avenue present a need for improvements. The installation of a new fence and gate will increase the security around the center. Also, development of an exterior patio on the northwest corner of the building will provide an area for outdoor community engagement.

The scope of the proposed project includes building a new exterior patio approximately 500-square-foot, an Americans with Disabilities Act accessible ramp, an approximately 17- by 18-foot shade structure, a new stainless-steel counter, a sink, and replacing approximately 250 linear feet of existing fence with a new security fence approximately 7 feet high along South Carlton Avenue of the project boundary. The project scope also includes replacing the entry gate on South Carlton Avenue. An existing pine tree will be removed.

The project would assist in achieving the goal of the Supportive Services Program, which is to promote and maintain independent living for older adults over the age of 60. The project will promote socialization and ensure access to older adult services.

<u>Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals</u>

These recommendations support the County Strategic Plan: Strategy III.3, Pursue Operational Effectiveness, Fiscal Responsibility, and Accountability, Objective III.3.2, Manage and Maximize County Assets, as the proposed project entails addressing efforts to manage and improve public infrastructure assets.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The total project cost is estimated at \$1,064,000, which includes plans and specifications, jurisdictional approval, construction, change orders, consultant services, miscellaneous expenditures, and County services (see Enclosure A). The facility design and consultant services costs of \$42,000 were paid from Utility User Tax, Cy Pres II, funds in Fiscal Year 2021-22. The appropriation adjustment (see Enclosure B) will transfer \$1,022,000 of Utility User Tax, Cy Pres II, funds, held in the Extraordinary Maintenance Budget to the Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project, Capital Project No. 87914, to fully fund the project.

Operating Budget Impact

The Department of Aging and Disabilities does not anticipate any one-time start-up costs, or an increase in ongoing maintenance and operational costs following completion of the proposed project.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

A standard construction contract, in a form previously approved by County Counsel, will be used that contains terms and conditions supporting the Board's ordinances, policies, and programs including, but not limited to, County's Greater Avenues for Independence and General Relief Opportunities for Work Programs, Contract Language to Assist in

Placement of Displaced County Workers, and Notice to Employees Regarding the Federal Earned Income Credit (Federal Income Tax Law, Internal Revenue Service Notice 1015). The plans and specifications include the contractual provisions, methods, and material requirements necessary for the proposed project and are on file with Public Works' Business Relations and Contracts Division, 900 South Fremont Avenue, 8th Floor, Alhambra, CA 91803-1331.

To ensure the contract is awarded to a responsible contractor with a satisfactory history of performance, the bidder will be required to report violations of the False Claims Act, their civil litigation history, and information regarding prior criminal convictions.

The proposed project will comply with Board Policy 5.270, Countywide Local and Targeted Worker Hiring Policy.

In accordance with the Board's consolidated Local and Targeted Worker Hire Policy adopted on September 6, 2016, the project will include a best effort hiring goal that at least 30 percent of the total California craft worker hours for construction of the project be performed by Local Residents and will not include a Targeted Worker component.

In accordance with the Board's Civic Art Policy, adopted on December 7, 2004, and last amended on August 4, 2020, the project budget for the proposed Willowbrook Senior Center Remodel Project includes 1 percent of eligible design and construction costs for a total of \$7,000 to be allocated to the Civic Art if spent on-site in accordance with the scope restrictions and within the construction period.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

The proposed project is categorically exempt from CEQA. The project is within certain classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment in that it meets criteria set forth in Sections 15301 (c), (d), (f), and (h); 15302 (c); 15303 (e); 15304 (f); and 15311 of the State CEQA Guidelines; and Classes 1 (c), (i), (j), and (h); 2 (a) and (e); 3 (b); and 11 of the County's Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines, Appendix G, since the project consists of renovations, installation of equipment, replacement of building features where replacement facilities at the site will have substantially the same purpose, capacity, and placement of minor accessory structures. There will be no expansion of use of the facility, which will continue to provide services to seniors.

In addition, based on the proposed project records, it will comply with all applicable regulations and is not located in a sensitive environment. There are no cumulative impacts, unusual circumstances, damage to scenic highways, listing on hazardous waste site lists compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5, or indications that it

may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource that would make the exemption inapplicable.

Upon the Board's approval of the proposed project and related actions, Public Works will file a Notice of Exemption with the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk in accordance with Section 21152 of the California Public Resources Code and will post the Notice of Exemption to the County's website pursuant to Section 21092.2.

CONTRACTING PROCESS

Advertising for construction bids will be in accordance with the County's standard Instruction Sheet for Publishing Legal Advertisements (see Enclosure C).

The contract opportunity will be listed on the County's "Doing Business with Us" and "Do Business with Public Works" websites. Public Works will also inform the local Small Business Enterprises, Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise, Social Enterprise, and Community Business Enterprise about this opportunity for those certified by the County of Los Angeles Department of Economic Opportunities.

<u>IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)</u>

Approval of the recommended actions will have no impact on current County services or programs. Willowbrook Senior Center will remain open to the public during construction, and the work will be phased and performed to minimize disruption or impediments to public access.
