Los Angeles County Gender-Based Violence Definition

Gender-Based Violence or GBV is defined as: violent acts or a pattern of acts of assault, threats, humiliation and intimidation or other abuses that are used to harm, punish, or frighten due to a person's identified or perceived gender or sexual identity. GBV — includes but is not limited to, domestic violence, intimate partner violence, gendered cyber abuses, sexual harassment, sexual assault and exploitation, trafficking, homophobic and transphobic abuses.
