Priority Concern #1

SBC Recommendations & Requests

- Documenting patterns of these deaths, missing corrective action reports from LASD
- Concern regarding overdoses and how substances are getting inside facilities
- Recommendation: Increased staff screening that matched the planned increased screening of incarcerated people

Long Standing Safety, Health & Infrastructure Concerns at MCJ

Priority Concern #2

SBC Recommendations & Requests

Long term:

- Closure of MCJ

Short term:

- Increased access to EBI programs
- More trustee recruitment
- Efficient tracking and faster turnaround for grievance forms
- Food / nutrition focus

General Barriers to Commission Efficacy

Priority Concern #3

SBC Recommendations & Requests

- Inspections with Board offices
 - Justice Deputy bi-annual jail visits
 - Supervisor annual jail visits
- Limitations to 2 monthly inspections per commissioner

Request

- Board to share our reports in additional locations
 - LASD website
 - Board member websites

Dedicated SBC Phone Line

Priority Concern #4

SBC Recommendations & Requests

- Staffing for a M-F business hours SBC specific phone line, in order to:
 - Increase commission accessibility to currently incarcerated people
 - Allow currently incarcerated people to share concerns, retaliatory actions following commissioner visits, and request inspections

Menstrual Products

Priority Concern #5

SBC Recommendations & Requests

- Strong stance against withholding menstrual products as punishment
- Consistently replenishing menstrual products in cells, in addition to day rooms

High Commissary Prices Impact on Incarcerated People & their Families

Priority Concern #6

SBC Recommendations & Requests

- For people's health and wellbeing, commissary prices need to be significantly reduced
- Increased availability of food and special diets being met on a quicker turnaround
