## Fiscal Year 2025-26 New and Revised Fees Board Letter

### WHY?

Budget Curtailment - \$22.2M

- 8.5% curtailment of ongoing NCC funding, amounting to \$18.2 million
- \$4.0 million ongoing NCC rescinded for lifeguard positions for the summer pool season and second person for nighttime park closure and staff safety

Adjustment in fees necessary to fund two-people for nighttime park closures (\$2.4M) to maintain hours of operation, core programming and provide staff safety and to sustain full-time positions, backfill for summer aquatics season,

- Annual review consistent with County Fiscal Manual
- Revisions based on benchmarking of fees for similar services by other park agencies
- Various fee adjustments based on the Consumer Price Index of California

## Fiscal Year 2025-26 New and Revised Fees Board Letter Fee Benchmarking

#### Fee Benchmarking Process

Fee benchmarking is a best practice and systemic process used by Park and Recreation Departments of comparing existing fees with similar fees charged by comparable park agencies locally and across the nation. This process analyzes the current fee structure, benchmarks against park standards and best practices, and establishes or updates existing fees to remain competitive, fair and ensure transparency.

## Fiscal Year 2025-26 New and Revised Fees Board Letter Arboreta and Botanic Gardens Fees

### **Recommendations**

- FY 2025-26 Adult Admission Fees from \$15 to \$18
  - $\circ$  \$3 increase
    - \$2 to DPR Operating Budget
    - > \$1 to the Gardens' Foundation
- FY 2026-27 Adult Admission Fees from \$18 to \$20
  - \$2 increase
    - > \$2 to the Gardens' Foundation
    - Amend Operating Agreements with Garden Foundations for community benefit, change admission fees, and modify Revenue Sharing
- This fee increase is lower than the national benchmark of \$25.85 average and \$24 median per ticket.

Please Note: In an unprecedented effort and demonstrated partnership, the Gardens have unanimously approved this revenue sharing structure to help avert further curtailments to DPR's programs and services.

## Fiscal Year 2025-26 New and Revised Fees Board Letter Arboreta and Botanic Gardens New Community Benefit

### **New Community Benefit**

- Free admission for Los Angeles County residents who hold an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card impacting over \$1.3M children, seniors and families:
  - Los Angeles County Arboretum and Botanic Garden
  - Descanso Gardens
  - South Coast Botanic Garden
  - Virginia Robinson Gardens
- Metro LIFE program: EBT cardholders may be eligible for free or discounted fares.
- Replaces free admission on the third Tuesday of every month at the Los Angeles Arboretum and Botanic Garden, Descanso Gardens and South Coast Botanic Garden.

### **Existing Community Benefit**

• Provides free access for youth through public school field trips that have an executed School Memorandum of Agreement.

  - o Whittier Narrows Recreation Area
  - o Castaic Lake State Recreation Area
- \$3 increase in Vehicle Entrance Fees
  - \$2 to DPR's Operating Budget
  - \$1 from each vehicle entrance and boat launch fee to the Special Development Fund (SDF)
    - Addresses contractual obligations with the State of California for Castaic Lake State Recreation Area and Kenneth Hahn State Recreation Area and the Army Corps of Engineers for Santa Fe Dam Recreation Area and Whittier Narrows Recreation Area

### Please note:

- Free access to residents via walking, scooters, bicycling, wheelchairs, rideshare and public transportation.
- Parking fees are only charged at 6 regional parks out of 183 parks
