Background & Purpose

- The Marvin Braude Bike Path is a 22-mile trail stretching from Pacific Palisades to Torrence, connecting multiple coastal cities
- January 2023 winter storm damage to the bike path (segment between Dockweiler Beach and Ballona Creek) and emergency declarations
- Repair and realign the damaged portion of the bike path at Dockweiler Beach
- Project funded through 2nd District Transportation Improvement Program funds

Directives (1-3)

- Find that the proposed bike path realignment project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- Approve the realignment project and authorize the Director of Public Works to finalize/adopt the project's plans and specifications; advertise the project for construction bids.
- Delegate authority to the Director of Public Works to instruct the Executive Officer of the Board to publish the legal advertisement and Notice Inviting Bids (when the project is ready to go out for bidding).

Directives (4-6)

- Delegate authority to the Director of Public Works to evaluate the bids and determine whether the lowest apparent bidder meets all required criteria.
- Delegate authority to the Director of Public Works to award and execute the construction contract.
- Delegate authority to the Director of Public Works to manage the contract.
