Hollywood Bowl Transit Overview

- **17,500 seats and limited parking in one of the densest regions of LA County.**
- **Park & Ride has existed for over 50 years in partnership with Los Angeles County.**
- **Successful transit program with 40.5% utilization.**
 - Ridership from 2023-2025 increased by 18%
- **Hollywood Bowl is a model transit program.**
 - Los Angeles Dodgers, the Olympics, and SoFi Stadium look to LA Phil to learn how we manage transit.
 - A mutual success between Los Angeles County and LA Phil.
- **Mutual Goals for the Program**
 - Keep access countywide
 - Incentivize the use of transit
 - Minimize environmental impact
 - Mitigate traffic

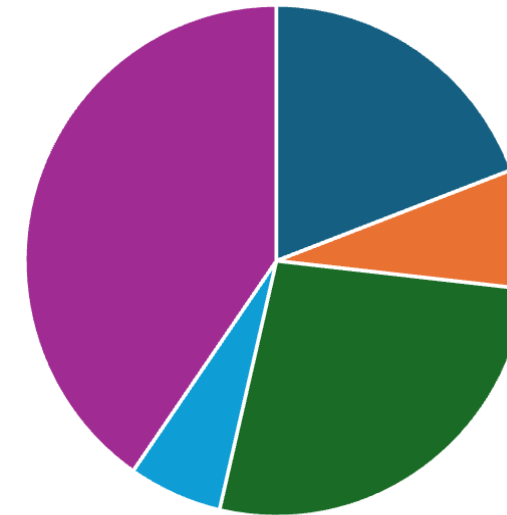

Percentage of Ridership by Region for each Shuttle Line

- Shuttle lots serve as regional convenience hubs en route to the Hollywood Bowl.
- They allow for ease of exit from the venue (no stacked parking).
- They have served as overflow when lots are sold out.
- LA Phil subsidized over 13,321 Metro TAP card rides during the 2026 season, which equal close to \$80K in revenue.
