




Total Population, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Age Distribution, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Race and Ethnicity Distribution, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Median Household Income, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Income Less than 100% FPL, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Income Less than 100% FPL by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Educational Attainment, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





High School Graduate or Higher by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Bachelor's Degree or Higher by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





No Health Insurance Coverage by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Life Expectancy at Birth by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021










Percent of Children (0-17 Years) Ever Diagnosed with Asthma by Race and Ethnicity¹, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021



All-Cause Mortality, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2022





All-Cause Mortality by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2020-2022





Infant Mortality by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2020





Coronary Heart Disease Mortality by Race and Ethnicity, San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021





Percent of Adults (18 Years and Older) Who Are Current Smokers¹ by Race and Ethnicity², San Diego and Los Angeles Counties, 2021










