NATURE OF CASE

On April 28, 2015, Plaintiffs Marc and Kimberly Hepperle were allegedly injured as a result of a motorcycle versus automobile collision involving an on-duty employee of the Department of Children and Family Services. They sustained numerous injuries including a torn rotator cuff for Mr. Hepperle and a cervical spine disc injury for Ms. Hepperle. They claim medical expenses, loss of earnings in an unspecified amount, and general damages for pain and suffering.

Due to the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a full and final settlement of the case in the amount of \$450,000, of which the County will pay \$250,000 and the County driver's private insurance will pay \$200,000, is recommended.
