NATURE OF CASE

collision when the Chevrolet Tahoe sport utility vehicle driven by defendant Jaime Alvarez-Ruiz ran a red light and struck two vehicles, one of which was driven by plaintiff John Goslin. Plaintiffs Stacey Goslin and Danielle Bain were passengers in Mr. Goslin's vehicle. The force of the impact caused Mr. Goslin's vehicle to back into a fourth vehicle. The accident occurred just after midnight on October 10, 2017, at the intersection of Arbor Vitae Street and Airport Boulevard, in the City of Inglewood. Deputy Sheriffs were pursuing Mr. Alvarez-Ruiz because he was driving recklessly by speeding and driving without his headlights turned on. Just after the deputies ceased their pursuit, the collisions occurred. Plaintiffs claim to have suffered injuries and damages as a result of the accident. Due to the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a full and final settlement of the case is warranted.

NATURE OF CASE

This is a recommendation to settle for \$450,000, inclusive of attorneys' fees and costs, a lawsuit filed by Andre McClelland ("Plaintiff") against the County and several deputy defendants, alleging civil rights violations. The lawsuit arose from an altercation between Plaintiff and another inmate at Men's Central Jail on August 28, 2018. Plaintiff alleges that the deputies facilitated the fight.

Given the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a reasonable settlement at this time will avoid further litigation costs. The full and final settlement amount

of \$450,000 is recommended.

NATURE OF CASE

On August 31, 2018 Ms. Morales, a 28-year-old female who was 39 weeks pregnant was admitted to Olive View Medical Center ("OVMC") for routine induction of labor. On September 2, 2018, Ms. Morales underwent a cesarean section.

Ms. Morales and her newborn infant were later transferred to UCLA Medical Center where they both died within one week as a result of an indiscernible and previously undiagnosed genetic condition that Ms. Morales suffered from.

Ms. Morales's husband, and their minor son, filed a wrongful death action against the County contending that OVMC failed to provide adequate medical care to Ms. Morales, which caused her death and the death of her newborn infant.

At 9:39 a.m., the Chairperson convened the meeting into Closed Session to discuss the items listed as 4(a) through 4(i).

4. Report of actions taken in Closed Session.

At 10:59 a.m., the Claims Board reconvened in open session and reported the actions taken in Closed Session as follows:

a. Cogen Landfill Claim

This claim alleges that the County failed to comply with the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services, Solid Management Waste Program order to install a gas control system at the Cogen Landfill.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$95,000.

b. <u>J.C. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> United States District Court Case No. 18-CV-03045-DMG-FFM

This federal lawsuit alleges Plaintiffs' civil rights were violated when social workers wrongfully detained her child.

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$25,000.

c. Hani Yasin, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al. United States District Court Case No. 18-CV-001178

This federal lawsuit alleges Plaintiffs' civil rights were violated when employees from the Department of Children and Family Services wrongfully detained her children.

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$750,000.

d. <u>Angela Kodzhanyan v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC 712402

This dangerous condition lawsuit arises from Plaintiff's injuries due to an alleged slip and fall on a set of stairs at the clinic tower at LAC+USC Medical Center.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$65,000.

e. <u>Peprone Adzhyan, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC 18STCV09379
