NATURE OF CASE

This is a recommendation to settle for \$450,000, inclusive of attorneys' fees and costs, a lawsuit filed by Andre McClelland ("Plaintiff") against the County and several deputy defendants, alleging civil rights violations. The lawsuit arose from an altercation between Plaintiff and another inmate at Men's Central Jail on August 28, 2018. Plaintiff alleges

that the deputies facilitated the fight.

Given the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a reasonable settlement at this time will avoid further litigation costs. The full and final settlement amount

of \$450,000 is recommended.
