NATURE OF CASE On September 16, 2017, Plaintiff Kevin Lewin was

involved in a motor vehicle versus bicycle collision with co-defendant Albert Thorne. The collision took place during the Malibu Triathlon, for which the Sheriff's Department was providing traffic control. Plaintiff was participating in the cycling portion of the

event at the time of the collision, wherein

co-defendant Albert Thorne, turned right in front of Plaintiff at the intersection of Pacific Coast Highway and Encinal Canyon Road. It is alleged that the Deputy Sheriff responsible for controlling the subject intersection was grossly negligent in providing traffic

control which caused the collision. Plaintiff sustained a fractured left clavicle which required surgery to repair and emotional and psychological

injuiries as a result of the collision.

Due to the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a full and final settlement of the case in the amount of

\$125,000 is recommended.
