a. Non-Litigated Claims of Jorge A. Gomez, Jr.

This claim involves personal injuries and property damage allegedly sustained in a vehicle accident involving a Sheriff's Department deputy.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of this matter in the amount of \$61,775.82.

b. <u>Jennie Sandoval v. County of Los Angeles, et al</u> Los Angeles County Superior Court Case No. 20STCV07440

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of this matter in the amount of \$300,000.

The Claims Board approved settlement of this matter in the amount of \$49,000.

d. <u>Deborah Connaughton v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles County Superior Court Case No. 19STCV01073

This lawsuit concerns allegations that an employee of the Department of Health Services was subjected to disability discrimination, failure to accommodate, and retaliation.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of this matter in the amount of \$325,000.

e. <u>Claudia Chavez v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> United States District Court Case No. 2:19-CV-10735-JAK-RAO

This lawsuit concerns allegations that plaintiff, who is deaf, was not given a qualified sign language interpreter by the Department of Health Services prior to having a surgical procedure at Los Angeles County + University of Southern California Medical Center.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of this matter in the amount of \$250,000.
