concrete section of the sidewalk, and she fell and sustained injuries. Plaintiff filed a lawsuit for

negligence and dangerous against Temple City and the County. The City also filed a cross-complaint against the County seeking indemnification. Given the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a full and

final settlement of the case is warranted.
