At the time of the incident, Los Angeles Sheriff's Deputies ("LASD") were responding to a suspicious person call. Upon arrival, Mr. Venegas charged at Deputies with a wooden stake, leading to a Deputy-

involved shooting.

The Deputies deny the allegations and contend their

actions were reasonable.

Given the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a reasonable settlement at this time will avoid further litigation costs. The full and final settlement of the case in the amount of \$2,750,000 is recommended.
