This federal civil rights lawsuit alleges excessive force against Sheriff's Department staff at Men's Central Jail; settlement is recommended in the amount of \$35,000.

d. Jane Doe V.L. v. County of Los Angeles, et al. Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 20STCV47892

This lawsuit alleges negligence against the Department of Children and Family Services for injuries plaintiff suffered while in foster care; settlement is recommended in the amount of \$600,000.

e. <u>Pamela Mejia v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 20STCV088

This lawsuit concerns allegations that a Department of Children and Family Services employee was subjected to failure to accommodate and failure to engage in the interactive process; settlement is recommended in the amount of \$130,000.

f. <u>Yvonne Santos v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 19STCV03494

This lawsuit concerns allegations that a Sheriff's Department employee was subjected to sexual harassment and retaliation; settlement is recommended in the amount of \$99,000.

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

APRIL 3, 2023

1. Call to Order.

The meeting of the Los Angeles County Claims Board was called to order at 9:50 a.m. The meeting was held via teleconference with all Claims Board Members participating telephonically. 2. Opportunity for members of the public to address the Claims Board on items of interest within the subject-matter jurisdiction of the Claims Board.

Three members of the public were on the public teleconference phone line to address the Claims Board. Two persons identified themselves as Daniel Lewis and Amy Williams, and that they were attorneys for the persons claiming damages in items 3.f. and 3.g. The third member of the public did not wish to address the Board.

3. Closed Session – Conference with Legal Counsel – Existing Litigation (Subdivision [a] of Government Code section 54956.9).

At 9:51 a.m., the Chair convened the meeting into closed session to discuss the items listed as 4(a) through 4(I).

4. Report of actions taken in Closed Session.

No members of the public were on the public teleconference phone line to hear the reportable actions of the Claims Board.

At 12:36 p.m., the Claims Board reconvened in open session via the public teleconference phone line and reported the actions taken in closed session as follows:

a. <u>Hermelinda Escobedo v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 19STCV37304

This medical malpractice lawsuit against the Department of Health Services alleges plaintiff suffered injuries while receiving care at Los Angeles County+USC Medical Center.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.a. in the amount of \$135,000.

b. Meshealle Sheffield v. County of Los Angeles

Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 21STCV38118

This medical malpractice lawsuit against the Department of Health Services alleges plaintiff suffered injuries while receiving care at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.b. in the amount of \$245,000.

c. <u>Robert Griendling, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 21STCV25378

This dangerous condition lawsuit arises from injuries allegedly sustained in a bicycle accident at a Recreational Vehicle lot maintained by the Department of Beaches and Harbors.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.c. in the amount of \$287,500.

d. <u>Victor Anderson, et al. v. Rafael Rufino, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC665088

This lawsuit arises from injuries plaintiff allegedly sustained in automobile accident involving a Sheriff's Department employee.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.d. in the amount of \$125,000.

Vote: Ayes: 3 – Steve Robles, Oscar Valdez, and Adrienne M. Byers

e. <u>Demetra Johnson, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No: 19STCP04664

This lawsuit involves the production of records by the Sheriff's Department under the California Public Records Act

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.e. in the amount of \$592,000.

f. <u>Arcadio Marin v. County of Los Angeles</u> Tax Claim

This claim alleges breach of contract by the Internal Services Department related to disputed home improvements undertaken pursuant to the PACE program.

The Claims Board deferred Item 4.f. for further discussion.

g. <u>Juan Carlos Garcia v. County of Los Angeles</u> Tax Claim

This claim alleges breach of contract by the Internal Services Department related to disputed home improvements undertaken pursuant to the PACE program.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board deferred Item 4.g. for further discussion.

Vote: Ayes: 3 – Steve Robles, Oscar Valdez, and Adrienne M. Byers

h. <u>Teresa Saldana Rodriguez v. County of Los Angeles</u> Tax Claim

This claim alleges breach of contract by the Internal Services Department related to disputed home improvements undertaken pursuant to the PACE program.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board deferred Item 4.h. for further discussion.

i. <u>Ernie Solano v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 20STCV24180

This lawsuit concerns allegations that a Probation Department employee was subjected to race and disability discrimination, and retaliation.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.i. in the amount of \$150,000.

j. <u>Ebonie Solin v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 20STCV35448

This lawsuit concerns allegations that a Department of Public Social Services employee was subjected to disability discrimination.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.j. in the amount of \$85,000.

k. Claim of Carl Kemp

This claim concerns allegations that a Department of Public Health employee was subjected to race discrimination and retaliation.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board continued Item 4.k. to a future meeting.

I. <u>Tigre Meeks v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC689181

The Claims Board conditionally approved settlement of Item 4.I. in the amount of \$61,500.
