At 12:21 p.m., the Claims Board reconvened in open session via video conference and reported the actions taken in closed session as follows:

a. Non-Litigated Claim of Spartan Recoveries

This claim seeks compensation for property damage caused by an automobile accident involving a Department of Public Works employee.

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.f. in the amount of \$275,000.

g. <u>Los Angeles Times Communications, LLC v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 20STCP02106

This lawsuit involves a dispute over the production of records by the Sheriff's Department under the California Public Records Act.

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.g. in the amount of \$160,000.
