4. Report on Actions Taken in Closed Session.

An unidentified caller listened as the reportable actions of the Claims Board were read.

At 12:23 p.m., the Claims Board reconvened in open session via video conference and reported the actions taken in closed session as follows:

a. Non-Litigated Claim of Juventino Jasso

This claim seeks compensation for personal injuries allegedly caused by an automobile accident involving a Department of Parks and Recreation employee.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.a. in the amount of \$24,000.

b. Sanjiv Agrawal, Kusum Agrawal v. County of Los Angeles, et al.

This petition to rescind a sale of tax-defaulted property and resolve claims for damages alleging the Treasurer-Tax Collector wrongfully foreclosed on a 2005 tax sale.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.b. in the amount of \$90,000.

c. <u>Aaron Esquenazi, et al. v. County of Los Angeles</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 19STCP02885

This class action lawsuit against the Treasurer-Tax Collector alleges the department extraterritorially imposed and collected utility user tax in former unincorporated areas of the County that were annexed by incorporated cities.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.c. in the amount of \$310,000.

d. Apartment Association of Los Angeles County, Inc.dba "Apartment Association of Great Los Angeles" et al. v. County of Los Angeles

Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 22STCV08225

This lawsuit for injunctive relief involves the Chief Executive Office and the Department of Consumer and Business affairs and seeks compensation for attorney's fees in a housing dispute.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.d. in the amount of \$75,000.

e. <u>Jerry Mostad v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 20STCV43700

This lawsuit arises from injuries allegedly sustained in an automobile accident involving a Department of Public Works employee.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.e. in the amount of \$2,750,000.

f. Anthony Espinoza v. Jeffrey Raymond Williams, et al. Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 21STCV14097

This lawsuit arises from injuries allegedly sustained in an automobile accident involving a Sheriff's Department detective.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.f. in the amount of \$50.000.

Vote: Ayes: 3 – Steve Robles, Adrienne M. Byers, and Oscar Valdez

g. <u>Olga Torres v. Cong Ha, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case Number 21STCV09926

This lawsuit arises from injuries allegedly sustained in an automobile accident involving a Sheriff's Department sergeant.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.g. in the amount of \$215,000.

Vote: Ayes: 3 – Steve Robles, Adrienne M. Byers, and Oscar Valdez

h. Non-Litigated Claims of Auto Club ASO Cuong Tang, Mo Chen, and Po Jui Su

These claims seek compensation for personal injury and property damage allegedly caused by an automobile accident involving a Sheriff's Department deputy.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.h. in the amount of \$39,288.33.

i. <u>Juan Leon, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al.</u> Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCV36328

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.i. in the amount of \$450,000.

j. Curtis Thomas v. County of Los Angeles Los Angeles Superior Court Number 22STCV01146

This lawsuit concerns allegations that an employee of the Department of Health Services was subjected to discrimination, harassment, and retaliation.

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.j. in the amount of \$100,000.

k. Wendy Valdovinos v. County of Los Angeles Los Angeles Superior Court No. BC680138

This lawsuit concerns allegations that an employee of the Department of Public Social Services was subjected to disability discrimination, failure to engage in the interactive process, and failure to accommodate.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board recommended to the Board of Supervisors settlement of Item 4.k. in the amount of \$250,000.
