4. Report on Actions Taken in Closed Session.

No members of the public were present to hear the reportable actions of the Claims Board.

At 12:31 p.m., the Claims Board reconvened in open session and reported the actions taken in closed session as follows:

a. Ruth Campbell v. City of Los Angeles, et al. **Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCV27418**

This dangerous condition of public property lawsuit arises from alleged injuries sustained from a slip and fall incident on a ramp to a portable restroom facility supplied by the County of Los Angeles.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.a. in the amount of \$50,000.

b. Non-litigated Claims of American Family Connect ASO Ismael Carbajal and Tesla Insurance Company ASO Earl Anthony Hibbert

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.d. in the amount of \$35,000.

**e. Kimberly Arnold, et al. v. Ford Motor Company, et al.

This wrongful death lawsuit alleges that the decedent suffered fatal injuries in a single-vehicle accident due to a dangerous condition of public property.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.e. in the amount of \$40,000.

f. **Bern J. Galvin v. County of Los Angeles, et al.**
Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCV37153

This dangerous condition of public property lawsuit arises from injuries allegedly sustained in a rollerblading accident on the Los Angeles River Bikeway.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.f. in the amount of \$50,000.

g. **Carlos Puga v. City of Los Angeles, et al.**
Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 20STCV34436

This dangerous condition of public property lawsuit arises from injuries allegedly sustained when Plaintiff fell off his bicycle riding down La Tuna Canyon Road.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.g. in the amount of \$99,000.

h. **Joshua Henry v. Anitria Michelle Tomlin, et al.**

This lawsuit arises from alleged injuries sustained in a vehicle accident when a Sheriff's lieutenant rear-ended Plaintiff.

Action Taken:

The Claims Board approved settlement of Item 4.h. in the amount of \$40,000.

i. **Non-Litigated Claims of Yue Jin & Jing Meng**
