3. Permit from Regional Planning

Commercial Sublease

- Required by master lease
- County Code Section 19.12.1270 B

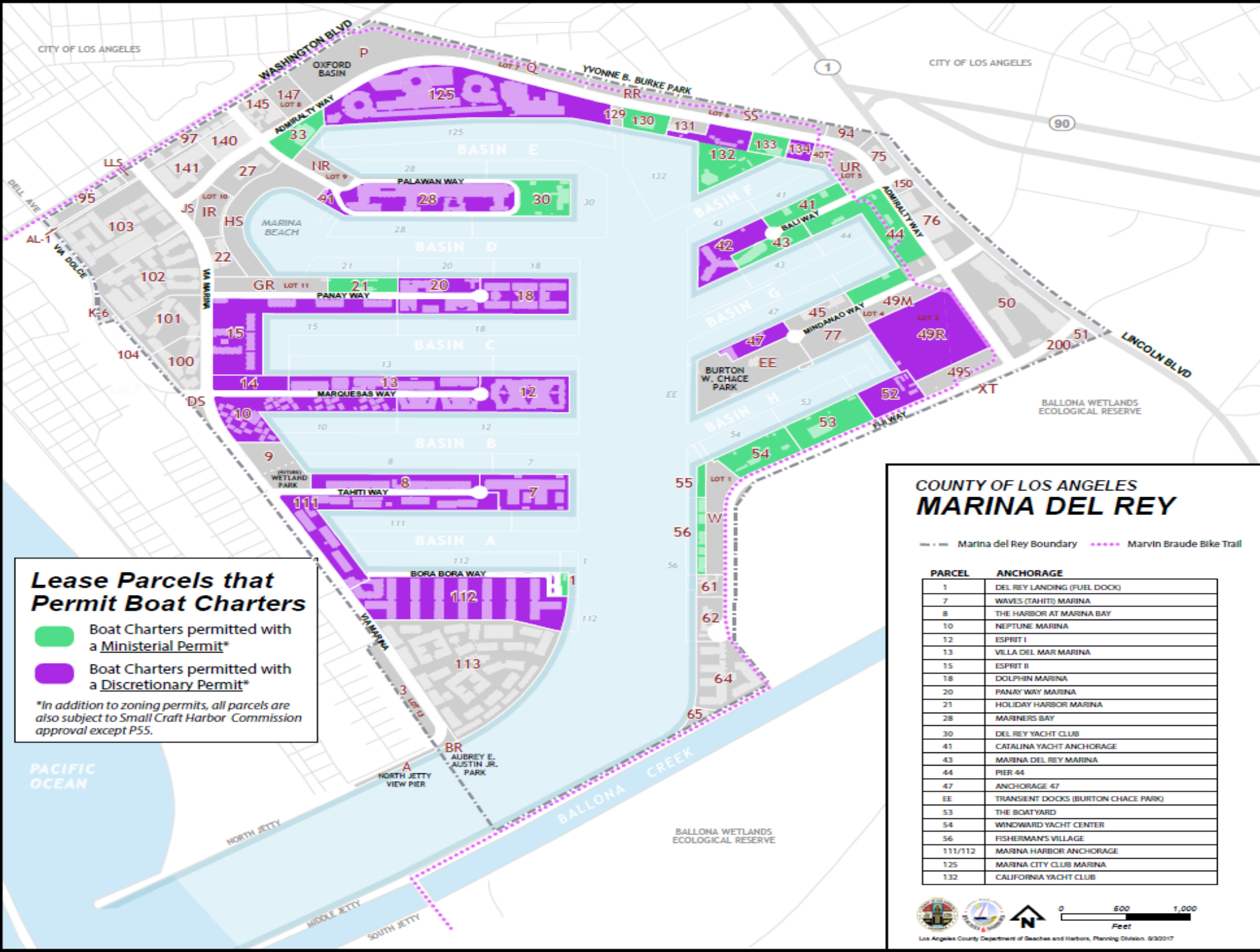
Related Use Hearing

1. There are no master leases that specifically allow for or prohibit chartering.
2. Director Policy Statement No. 17 Hearing:
 - a. Commission Member = Hearing Officer
 - b. Record of hearing to SCHC
 - c. Hearing Officer and Dept. to present their conclusions to the SCHC at regular meeting.

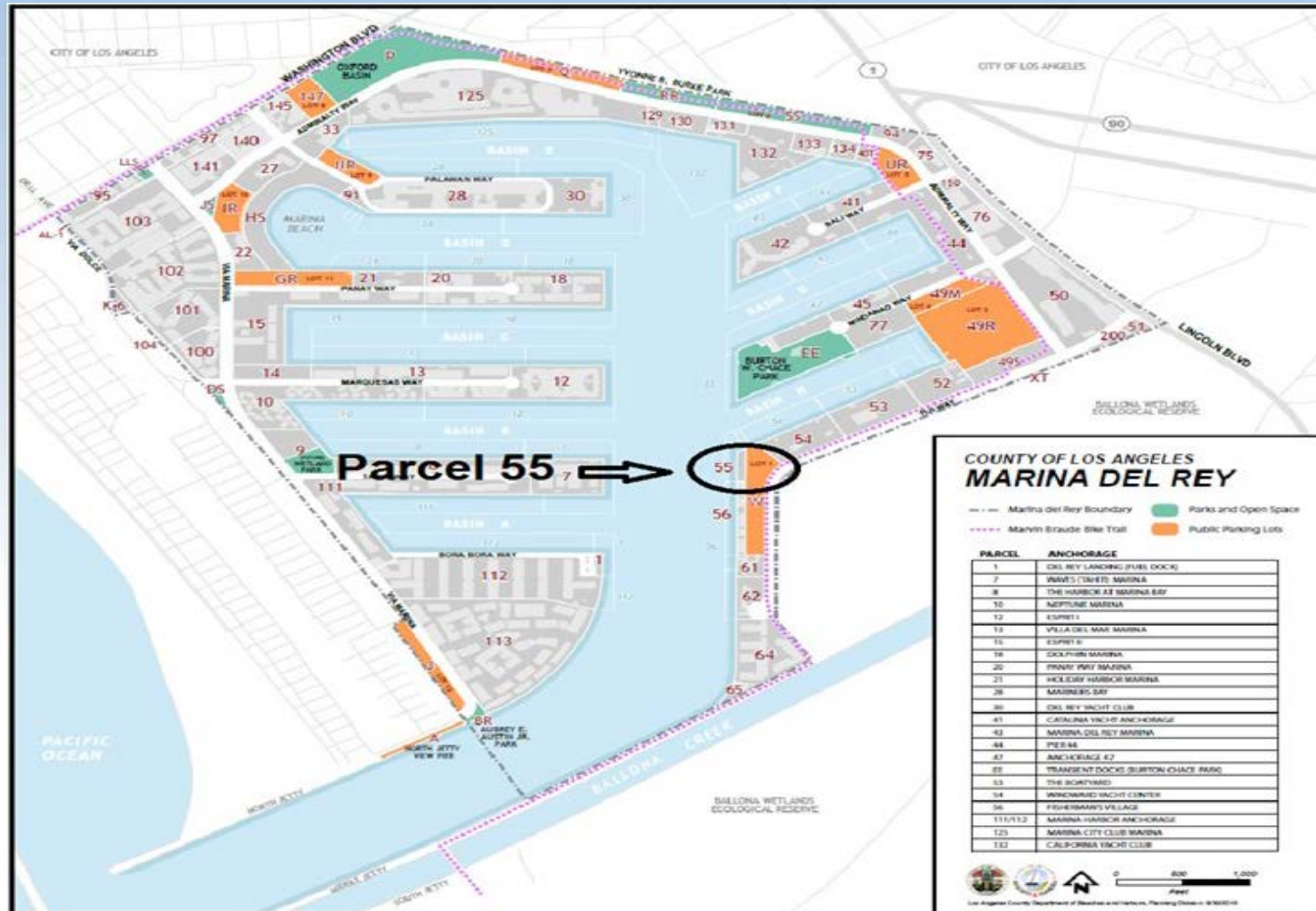
Regional Planning Permit

1. Ministerial Permit
 - a. Site Plan Review, Ministerial, Special Districts
 - b. \$1,001

2. Discretionary Permit
 - a. Conditional Use Permit
 - b. Hearing
 - c. \$9,143

- Captains Licensed by the USCG
- Boats are visually inspected and have documented and certified inspection forms
- Operators have insurance
- Operators have valid County business licenses
- Valid permits for serving food and alcohol
