Eligibility & Review Unit - In-Kind Income Affidavit Processing Guide

## Purpose:

 In-Kind Income Affidavit is used as a means of providing verification for applicants receiving free items of need such as housing, utilities, and food from other than a responsible relative. In-Kind Income may be either earned or unearned.

**Note:** A spouse cannot provide In-Kind Income to his/her spouse.

## In-Kind Income Processing Steps

- An In-Kind Income Affidavit should be complete for applicants receiving free housing, utilities, and food from someone other than a responsible relative.
- The In-Kind Income Affidavit must be thoroughly completed, signed by the applicant and the original sent to the person identified as providing the applicant with free housing, utilities, and food.
- The original Affidavit can be mailed to the provider or given to the applicant to have the provider complete are return.
- A ten day control should be set for the return of the signed Affidavit. If the Affidavit is not returned by the provider use the In-Kind chart amounts.
  - If the Affidavit is not return after ten day, you can process the MHLA application using the copy of the In-Kind Income Affidavit on file. A dollar value should be assigned to each free item received (Refer to Value Chart Attachment # 3)
  - Applications processed using In-Kind Affidavit without the provider's signature can be used as verification of income only. MHLA applications processed with <a href="both">both</a> the <a href="applicant">applicant</a> and <a href="provider's signature">provider's signature</a> can be used as verification of LA County residency and income.
