Los Angeles County College of Nursing and Allied Health is an associate degree nursing program that is designed to be completed in 2 years.

This program will cost \$13,900.00 if completed within the normal time. This amount does not include cost of living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting but may have changed.

A typical graduate who completes this program within the normal time leaves with \$26,800.00 of debt.

Graduates from the Los Angeles County College of Nursing and Allied Health are eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN) to become Registered Nurses.
