ERC SKILLS LAB-Benefits of Simulated Learning for Nurses


In 2019 the ERC has made many changes that supports student learning. For example, Building 10 is the new home for the skills and simulation labs, as well as the new computer lab. We are also excited about the new Skills Lab Coordinator Mrs. Tricia Imanaka. Ms. Imanaka has been teaching for the college since 2006 after transferring from LAC+USC's Surgical Intensive Care Unit where she worked for greater than five years. During the past three months Ms. Imanaka has taken on the undaunting task of organizing all of the supplies for both the skills and simulation labs. After the refurbishing of the rooms with fresh paint new floors, and signage, she has taken on the challenge of increasing the use of simulation in all semesters providing students with a safe place to learn. Mrs. Imanaka-Gong commented "It is fun to see the students try and figure out what is wrong with the mannequin, without causing serious implications. "She is also preparing to add a simulator for neonatal assessments, and four new task trainers to further increase simulated training here at the Los Angeles County College of Nursing and Allied Health.
