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To Whom It May Concern,

This letter shall serve as confirmation that My Health LA is not health insurance. My Health LA is a primary care health coverage program run by the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services (DHS). My Health LA participants receive no-cost primary care at DHS-contracted community health centers, and they receive specialty care and hospital care at DHS facilities. They will be charged for any healthcare provided outside of the DHS facilities or the DHS-contracted health centers.

All participants in My Health LA are uninsured. To qualify for My Health LA, enrollees must be aged 26 and older, live in Los Angeles County, earn at or below 138% of the Federal Poverty Level and be ineligible for comprehensive public health insurance such as Medi-Cal.
