WHAT IS A NAVIGATOR?

Cancer Navigators at DHS provide support and guidance throughout your treatment. Our navigators are trained professionals who can help address any barriers to care you may experience. They can help communicate your needs with your medical team, help you understand your diagnosis and treatment plan, assist in coordinating your appointments, as well as addressing any needs you may have at home (transportation, financial, etc).

A Cancer Navigator is automatically assigned to you when you receive a cancer diagnosis by your medical team and will follow-up with you after your first visit to see how they can help. - Guidance and education to help you understand your diagnosis and treatment.
- Communication with your medical team about any questions or concerns you may have during treatment.

- Assistance with transportation concerns, financial issues, insurance questions, disability applications, caregiver support and much more.
- Emotional support and linkage to support groups and clinical social work services.
