Identifies economic, cognitive or cultural barriers and determines their influence on the provision of care. Refers patients based on patients' needs and risk factors involved.
- Participate in patient care conferences, committee meetings, staff development, and educational programs to increase or maintain professional competency.
- Coordinate delivery of patient care with other services and disciplines to achieve optimal patient outcomes.
