- Describe the Pediatric Assessment Triangle and its use in the management of pediatric patients.

- Describe the differences in ECG findings and clinical management between STEMI and

NSTEMI.

- Review the management of patients with the provider impression, Chest Pain Suspected Cardiac (CPSC)
- Recognize ECG findings in cardiac ischemia.

- Describe the pediatric GCS.
