09/01/2023	New Medical Control Guideline	New Medical Control Guideline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Antifibrolynic indicated for hemmorage control in the prehospital setting for</li> <li>• Adult patients within 3 hours of traumatic injury with suspected internal truncal hemorrhage and systolic blood pressure (SBP) &lt; 90mmHg or heart rate&gt;SBP</li> <li>• Adult patients within 3 hours of traumatic injury with uncontrolled external/extremity hemorrhage despite applying pressure, and use of hemostatic agents and tourniquets where appropriate</li> <li>• Adult patients with post-partum hemorrhage as evidenced by ongoing bleeding and systolic blood pressure (SBP) &lt; 90mmHg or heart rate&gt;SBP or estimated blood loss &gt;500mL</li> </ul>
