Video of the Month

- Understand the most common triggers of anaphylaxis in pediatrics and adults.

Case of the Month

- Understand why anaphylaxis may lead to cardiac arrest.
- Know how to intervene effectively on the different symptoms of anaphylaxis
- Be able to interpret EtCO₂ waveforms in critically ill patients.

- Understand how to differentiate sinus tachycardia from other tachydyrhythmias.
- Know the general approach for treatment of sinus tachycardia.
