Routine order amounts should be based on historical use data and other internal considerations”• Revised information on drug storage<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Antiseptics and disinfectants must be stored separately from medications○ A mechanism for procuring, storing, distributing, and accounting for controlled drugs also applies to SCT units.• Removed “use of blanket extension expiration dates for medications in storage” from mitigation strategies

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
