### Correctional Health Services

Compassionate healthcare without judgment to our incarcerated populations.

### Emergency Medical Service

Oversees the local Emergency Medical System, including the designation of specialty care centers—such as trauma centers—and the coordination of prehospital services that provide lifesaving care to those in need, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

### Harm Reduction

Health and social services for individuals struggling with substance use disorders.

### Office of Diversion and Reentry

Diverts people with serious mental and/or physical health needs away from jail and into community-based care.
