Treatment And Prognosis

The typical age of onset of sporadic and inherited CJD is in the 50s to 70s. The initial presentation may be with: neuropsychiatric symptoms such as depression, apathy, or altered sleep; motor symptoms such as cerebellar ataxia, parkinsonism, myoclonus, or spasticity; or cognitive deficits in any domain. Once symptomatic, the illness typically is inexorably and rapidly progressive, with the majority of patients dying within 12 to 18 months. In some families, however, prion disease progresses slower and can mimic Alzheimer disease or Huntington disease ([Chapter 379](#)).

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Description

Tamoxifen is an oral selective estrogen receptor modulator (SERM), which has both estrogenic and antiestrogenic effects on various tissues. It competes with estrogen for binding to the estrogen receptor, which can decrease estrogen receptor signaling-dependent growth in breast tissue. It is approved for the adjuvant treatment of breast cancer and for the treatment of metastatic breast cancer. It is also used to reduce the risk of invasive breast cancer in women with ductal carcinoma in situ (DCIS) after surgery and radiation, and to reduce the risk of breast cancer in women at high risk for breast cancer. Serious and life-threatening events from the use of tamoxifen include uterine malignancies, stroke, and pulmonary embolism. 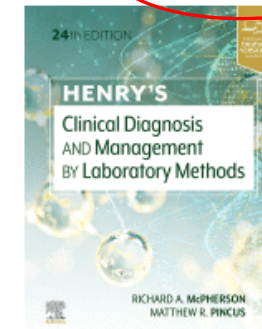

KEY POINTS

- High-throughput array technologies such as genomics and proteomics have provided unprecedented ability to personalize output of biomarkers implicated in select disease states.
- Pharmacogenomics, through utilization of novel technologies, can detect unique genomic alterations to serve as diagnostic, prognostic, or predictive biomarkers which relate to an individual or group response to particular therapies.

The Los Angeles County College of Nursing and Allied Health is a public community college that is owned and operated by the County of Los Angeles. The College supports the educational needs of the Los Angeles General Medical Center (LA General), Health Services, and the LA County healthcare community by providing learning-centered educational programs and career development opportunities for healthcare students.

In 1895 the College Training School for Nurses was founded under the direction of LAC Hospital and USC College of Medicine. The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors approved the School in 1901. The School was renamed the LAC Medical Center School of Nursing in 1968 to coincide with the hospital name change to the LA General Medical Center. In 1998, the school was renamed the LAC College of Nursing and Allied Health.

The College achieves its mission by graduating 100 to 150 students with an Associate of Science degree in Nursing every year. Over 98% of these SON graduates pass their national licensing exam. Staff from Health Services receive continuing education through the Division of Allied Health Continuing Education programs.
