

What Is Healthy Way LA (HWLA) Kids?

HWLA Kids is a Los Angeles County Department of Health Services (DHS) program that provides health care to children ages 6 to 18.

How Much Does It Cost?

HWLA Kids is free the first year for children who are no longer in L.A. Care's Healthy Kids as of March 1, 2013.

HWLA Kids members will be screened financially in March 2014.

What Are The HWLA Kids Benefits?

HWLA Kids offers benefits that are like L.A. Care's Healthy Kids.

HWLA Kids benefits include:

- · Doctor Visits at DHS sites
- Dental and Vision screening at DHS sites
- Hospital and Emergency Room Care at DHS sites
- Prescription Drugs at DHS sites
- Nurse Advice Line, open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

What Doctors And Specialists Are Available For *HWLA Kids*?

HWLA Kids members will be cared for by doctors and specialists in the DHS system of 19 clinics and 4 hospitals.

HWLA Kids members who need specialists will be checked and referred to the proper specialist or specialty program in the DHS system.

Does My Child Qualify For HWLA Kids?

Your child qualifies if he or she meets the following requirements:

- Your child has been a Healthy Kids member in the past year
- Your child still lives in Los Angeles County
- Your child is between the ages of 6 and 18
- Your child has no health insurance
