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Description of Site: *(Please describe the type of Agency setting and services offered)*

FACTS partners with (GENESIS) Geriatric Evaluation Network Encompassing Service Intervention Support Programs to serve seniors countywide and is 100% field based. Seniors are often reluctant to accept services associated with mental health treatment due to life experience or general stigma associated with mental illness. Teams of social workers and nurses collaborate to provide mental health services that are packaged with medical, case management and resource linkage services, which this specific population is more likely to respond to and accept. These interdisciplinary teams outreach seniors in various types of home settings, providing comprehensive health screenings. These screenings include review of vital signs and glucose assessments in addition to full mental health evaluations to assess level of harm risk.
