- ◆ The maintenance of two-way communication between the DMH and various groups and geographic communities

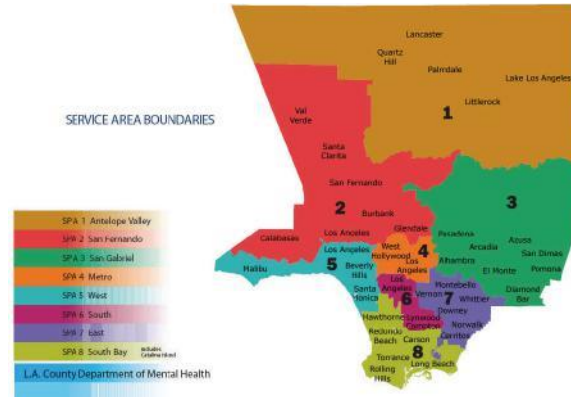
## You Can Help?
