**HEARING ON DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH'S
REVISED PUBLISHED CHARGES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004
(ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS)
(3 VOTES)**

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING:

Approve the revised Department of Mental Health's (DMH) Published Charges (Attachment I) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2003-2004, effective November 1, 2003, in order to comply with Federal Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal (SD/MC) Lower of Cost or Charges reimbursement (LCC) and routine cost principles' requirements.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

The Board approved DMH's Published Charges for FY 2003-2004 on June 24, 2003. Since DMH's current computerized billing system only permits the use of one rate table which reflects the June 24, 2003 Board approved Published Charges, the Published Charges for Mode-Service Function Codes 10-81 through 10-89 and 15-01 through 15-79 were SD/MC rates that did not include administrative overhead costs (SD/MC administrative costs are captured separately through DMH's SD/MC Administrative claim).

With DMH's Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliant Integrated System effective on October 16, 2003, DMH will have the ability to bill one rate for SD/MC claims and another rate for all other funding plans. Currently all non-Medi-Cal plans are not billed the administrative overhead costs because of the current system's limitation to one rate table. The implementation of the Integrated System will include more than the one rate table.

Therefore, Board action is required to revise the Published Charges to include administrative overhead costs for all services that will be billed to non-Medi-Cal plans. The current Published Charges approved by the Board on June 24, 2003, will continue to be used for billing the Medi-Cal plan only.

The recommended Published Charges comply with Federal SD/MC audit requirements, which took effect on July 1, 1992. Federal requirements stipulate that Published Charges are to be determined at the countywide level.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The recommended Board actions are consistent with the County's fourth goal— "Fiscal Responsibility", within the County Strategic Plan. This action will ensure that Published Charges are in compliance with Medi-Cal requirements thereby averting Federal Lower Costs or Charges (LCC) audit disallowance.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The subject does not apply.

Approval of these charges will accommodate requirements of the State Plan Amendment under Title IX of the Social Security Act for the State of California.

Federal Lower of Costs or Charges (LCC) audit disallowances will be avoided because of compliance. DMH has not included any charges, which are set by either State or Federal agencies for which it has no jurisdictional rate setting authority. DMH will bill those charges as directed by those authorities.

To the extent non-Medi-Cal plans will be billed for both the service and administrative overhead costs, because of the new schedule of Published Charges, there may be additional revenues received. It is premature to estimate any such revenues.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The original Published Charges for FY 2003-2004 were developed using actual cost report data for FY 2001-2002. This cost report data was adjusted by 1) the Federal Home Health Agency Market Basket Index, 2) DMH's Auditor-Controller approved Indirect Cost Rate Proposal (ICRP) percentages for all non SD/MC services, and 3) the State's SD/MC Maximum Allowance. The revised Published charges for FY 2003-2004 were developed using the same methodology; however, DMH's Auditor-Controller approved ICRP percentage was applied to all rates in order to capture administrative overhead costs. These charges are reflective of the present level of care.

Government Code Section 66018, added by stats. 1990, ch. 1572 (AB 3228), §20, requires the publication of notice and a public hearing to be held prior to the adoption of new fees or the increase of existing fees. Such a notice will be published at the minimum of 10 days prior to the public hearing.

CONTRACTING PROCESS

The subject does not apply since DMH's Published Charges apply only to DMH's directly operated clinics.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES

The recommended revised Published Charges will become effective November 1, 2003. Failure to establish these revised annual Published Charges will result in reduced revenues from non-Medi-Cal plans and/or if the charges are less than actual costs.

CONCLUSION
