SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS FOR NOVEMBER 2016**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of six Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal (MC) Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs, and execution of three new Agreements processed in the month of November 2016 as follows:

1. **Agreement (MH200460) with South Central Los Angeles Regional Center for Developmentally Disabled Persons, Inc.,** is a newly executed Master Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on November 3, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2019.
2. **Agreement (MH200459) with West Hollywood Community Housing Corporation** is a newly executed Master Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on November 15, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2019.
3. **Agreement (MH29852) with Sheree Jones-Pistol A Marriage And Family Therapy Corporation** is a newly executed Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on November 15, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2017.

The following two Amendments (4 and 5) revise the Contractor's Obligation as a Business Associate under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996 provision effective September 23, 2013, to incorporate additional and enhanced privacy and security requirements applicable to business associates. There is no change to the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA):

4. **Amendment No. 1 (MH200459) with West Hollywood Community Housing Corporation**
5. **Amendment No. 1 (MH200460) with South Central Los Angeles Regional Center for Developmentally Disabled Persons, Inc.**

The following three Amendments (6 through 8) increase MHSA Full Service Partnership (FSP) MC Funded Program funds:

6. **Amendment No. 19 with Hillview Mental Health Center, Inc.,** for Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 increases MHSA FSP MC Funded Program funds in the amount of \$159,990. The revised MCA is \$13,150,237.
7. **Amendment No. 19 with Tarzana Treatment Centers, Inc.,** for FY 2016-17 increases MHSA FSP MC Funded Program funds in the amount of \$159,990. The revised MCA is \$10,704,735.
8. **Amendment No. 40 with San Fernando Valley Community Mental Health Center, Inc.,** for FY 2016-17 increases MHSA FSP MC Funded Program funds in the amount of \$159,990. The revised MCA is \$38,179,122.

The following one Amendment (9) increases Specialized Foster Care (SFC) Wraparound MC Funded Program funds:

9. **Amendment No. 17 with Five Acres – The Boys' & Girls' Aid Society of Los Angeles** for FY 2016-17 increases SFC Wraparound MC Funded Program funds in the amount of \$332,640. The revised MCA is \$20,684,737.

Report Addendum

Addendum for May 2016

Addendum for October 2016

The following two Agreements (10 and 11) were executed and processed in the month of October 2016 as follows:

10. **Agreement (MH190137) with The Village Family Services** is a newly executed Drop-In Center for Transition Age Youth (TAY) Services Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on October 4, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2019.
11. **Agreement (MH190139) with Los Angeles Gay and Lesbian Community Services Center** is a newly executed Drop-In Center for TAY Services Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on October 4, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2019.

The following two Amendments (12 and 13) decrease/increase SFC Enhanced Mental Health Services MC Funded Program funds:
