SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 53 Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs and execution of four new Agreements processed in the month of April 2014 as follows:

1. **Amendment No. 9 (MH050042) with Mental Health America of Los Angeles** increases Service Extenders Wellness Outreach Workers Program funds in the amount of \$50,000. The revised Total Contract Amount (TCA) is \$724,800.
2. **Amendment No. 4 (MH050045) with Pacific Clinics** extends the term of the Agreement on a month-to-month basis for an additional six months, beginning July 1, 2014, through December 31, 2014, to continue MHSA Workforce Education and Training.
3. **Agreement (MH050147) with Jewish Family Services of Los Angeles** was executed under the Consultant Services Agreement from April 8, 2014, through June 30, 2017.
4. **Administrative Amendment No. 13A (MH9019) with The Regents of the University of California dba UCLA Neuropsychiatric Behavioral Health** deletes the current Additional Group Provider, Attachment VIII-12A, in its entirety and replaces it with Attachment VIII-13A.
5. **Agreement (MH010105) with Santa Monica College** was executed under the Affiliation Agreement from April 21, 2014, through June 30, 2014.
6. **Amendment No. 2 (MH120998) with Community Family Guidance Center** implements an Integrated Behavioral Health Information System to provide

clinical, administrative, financial, and data sharing functionality and support to enable Department of Mental Health (DMH) to meet the federal and State mandates for electronic health record.

7. **Amendment No. 3 (MH121079) with SPIRITT Family Services, Inc.**, is a technical correction to delete First 5 LA funds in the amount of \$2,485 for Parent and Child Interaction Therapy community outreach services. The revised Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) is \$658,333.
8. **Amendment No. 2 (MH190096) with Pacific Clinics** revises the Payment Schedule (Exhibit B) to incorporate the monthly invoice, Attachment I, (Drop-In Center Services Cost Invoice), under Section 3, Payment Procedures, to better reflect the intent of the parties under this program.
9. **Agreement (MH190117) with Women Shelter of Long Beach** was executed under the Enhanced Emergency Shelter Program for Transition Age Youth Agreement from April 2, 2014, through June 30, 2017.
10. **Agreement (MH200424) with The Right Way Foundation** was executed under the Master Agreement MHSA from April 15, 2014, through June 30, 2016.

The following two Amendments (11 and 12) to LE Agreements revise and incorporate additional and enhanced privacy and security language, by the delegated authority to the directors of all Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPPA)-covered departments to make all necessary alterations and adjustments to Business Associate Agreement language. There is no change to the MCA:

The revised MCA is \$8,342,101.
