SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 69 Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs and execution of ten new Agreements processed in the month of October 2013 as follows:

1. **Agreement (MH020044) with Medreach, Inc., dba Medreach Ambulance Service** the term of the Agreement under the Patient/Client Transportation Services Agreement is from October 28, 2013, through June 30, 2017.
2. **Agreement (MH120969) with Sun Bridge Shadin Hills Rehabilitation Center dba Shandin Hills Behavior Therapy Center, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Regency Health Services, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sun Bridge Healthcare, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sun Healthcare Group, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of GHC Holdings II, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Genesis HealthCare, LLC, the term of the Agreement under the LE Agreement is from October 9, 2013, through June 30, 2015.**

The following two Amendments (3 and 4) to LE Agreements implement the Project 60 Women and Children pilot program and Special Service for Group (SSG) Alliance Integrated Care Mobile Team with Homeless Services funds:

3. **Amendment No. 16 (MH120848) with Didi Hirsch Psychiatric Service** adds Homeless Services Non Medi-Cal/Non Healthy Families (HF) funds in the amount of \$261,355 and adds Homeless Services Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$309,526 for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2013-14 and 2014-15. The revised Maximum Contract Amounts (MCAs) are \$31,685,500 and \$30,115,464, respectively.

4. **Amendment No. 25 (MH120886) with SSG** adds Homeless Services Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$308,750 and \$243,750 for FYs 2013-14 and 2014-15, respectively; adds Homeless Services Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$32,500 and \$162,500 for FYs 2013-14 and 2014-15, respectively. The revised MCAs are \$38,092,636 and \$37,233,012, respectively.

The following three Agreements (5 through 7) are being executed under the Technological Needs Projects:

5. **Agreement (MH100320) with San Gabriel Children's Center, Inc.**, the term of the Agreement is from October 1, 2013, through June 30, 2016.
6. **Agreement (MH101150) with Behavioral Health Services, Inc.**, the term of the Agreement is from October 2, 2013, through June 30, 2016.
7. **Agreement (MH101853) with Eggleston Youth Centers, Inc.**, the term of the Agreement is from October 23, 2013, through June 30, 2016.

The following four Administrative Amendments (8 through 11) to LE Agreements enable the parties to add/delete and/or shift Group Providers by modifying the current Additional Group Providers attachments. There is no change to the MCA:

8. **Amendment No. 4A (MH120903) with Counseling4Kids** deletes Attachment VII-3 and replaces it with Attachment VII-4.
9. **Amendment No. 14A (MH120922) with PROTOTYPES, Centers for Innovation in Health, Mental Health and Social Services** deletes Attachment IV-13 and replaces it with Attachment IV-14A.
10. **Amendment No. 6A (MH120932) with the Village Family Services** deletes Attachment VIII-5 and replaces it with Attachment VIII-6A.
11. **Amendment No. 12A (MH120956) with SHIELDS for Families** deletes Attachment IV-11 and replaces it with Attachment IV-12A.

The following five Amendments (12 through 16) to LE and Specialized Agreements intend to change/correct the provider's name and/or delivery service site. There is no change to the MCA:

- 15. Amendment No. 1 (MH120950) with Korean American Family Services, Inc., a.k.a. Korean American Family Service Center, Inc.,** changes the name of the Contractor from Korean American Family Service Center, Inc., to Korean American Family Services, Inc.
- 16. Amendment No. 2 (MH200343) with HealthRIGHT 360, a.k.a. Haight Ashbury Free Clinics, Inc., dba Haight Ashbury Free Clinics-Walden House** changes the Contactor's name from Haight Ashbury Free Clinics, Inc., dba Haight Ashbury Free Clinics-Walden House to HealthRIGHT 360.

- 18. Agreement (MH200410) with Drumming for Your Life Institute** the term of the Agreement is from October 7, 2013, through June 30, 2016.
- 19. Agreement (MH200413) with Kohan International Foundation** the term of the Agreement is from October 3, 2013, through June 30, 2016.

20. **Agreement (MH200414) with Fellowship Christian Center** the term of the Agreement is from October 2, 2013, through June 30, 2016.
21. **Agreement (MH200415) with The New You Center, Inc.**, the term of the Agreement is from October 28, 2013, through June 30, 2016.

The following seven Amendments (22 through 28) to LE Agreements increase/decrease and/or shift MHSA, Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI), Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS), Full Service Partnership (FSP), for Non Medi-Cal/Non HF and Medi-Cal HF funds:

22. **Amendment No. 11 (MH120834) with Alma Family Services** increases MHSA PEI Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$35,000 for FY 2013-14 only. The revised MCA is \$11,902,930.
23. **Amendment No. 15 (MH120848) with Didi Hirsch Psychiatric Service** increases MHSA FSP Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$72,107; increases MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$589,387; decreases MHSA FCCS Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$72,107; and decreases MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$589,387. There is no change to the MCA.
24. **Amendment No. 29 (MH120876) with Pacific Clinics** decreases FCCS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 and increases FSP Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 for FY 2013-14 only. There is no change to the MCA.
25. **Amendment No. 6 (MH120911) with Heritage Clinic and The Community Assistance Program for Seniors** decreases MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$1,143,800; decreases match funds in the amount of \$571,900; decreases MHSA FCCS Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$207,500; increases MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$571,900; and increases MHSA FSP Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$207,500 for FY 2013-14 only. There is no change to the MCA.
26. **Amendment No. 10 (MH120918) with Mental Health America of Los Angeles** increases MHSA FSP Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$497,654; increases MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$740,917; decreases MHSA FCCS Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$497,654; and decreases MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$740,917. There is no change to the MCA.

27. **Amendment No. 22 (MH120924) with San Fernando Valley Community Mental Health Center, Inc.**, shifts funds from FCCS Non Medi-Cal/Non HF to FSP Non Medi-Cal/Non HF in the amount of \$127,800 and shifts funds from FCCS Medi-Cal/HF to FSP Medi-Cal/HF in the amount of \$2,636,974. There is no change to the MCA.
28. **Amendment No. 6 (MH210021) with St. John's Well Child And Family Center, Inc.**, increases MHSA PEI funds for the provision of Specialty Mental Health Services in the amount of \$98,049. The Estimated Maximum Amount (EMA) is \$475,111.
