SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 94 Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs and execution of 21 new Agreements processed in the month of May 2010, as follows:

1. **Amendment No. 17 (MH010054) with The Regents of the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA)** adds \$216,000 of MHSA Workforce, Education and Training (WET) Regional Partnership funds to expand services pertaining to Addendum A (Countywide Academic and Medical Teaching Services Program). The revised Total Contract Amount (TCA) will be \$3,866,803.
2. **Amendment No. E6 (MH050013) with California Institute for Mental Health** adds MHSA funds by \$37,500 for the provision of Functional Family Therapy training services. The revised TCA will be \$1,364,700.
3. **Amendment No. 3 (MH050031) with Law Office of Kim Savage** adds MHSA Community Services and Supports (CSS) Plan funds by \$20,000 to provide siting training to David and Margaret Home, Inc., and PATH Ventures. For Fiscal Years (FYs) 2009-10 and 2010-11, the total increase to the TCA will be \$20,000.
4. **Agreement (MH100801) with Providence Community Service, LLC**, is being executed for the purpose of conducting MHSA Information Technology (IT) Projects, with a TCA of \$225,360.
5. **Amendment No. 3 (MH120434) with California Institute of Health and Social Services, Inc., dba Alafia Mental Health Institute** moved the location of Provider Number (PN) 7655 from 3701 Stocker Street, Suite 310, Los Angeles,

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CA 90008 to 3856 Santa Rosalia Drive, Suite 628, Los Angeles, CA 90008. There is no change to the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA).

6. **Amendment No. 6 (MH120453) with Hathaway-Sycamores Child and Family Services** adds on going Katie A. funding by \$160,000 for FYs 2009-10, 2010-11, and 2011-12, with a revised MCA of \$34,346,098.
7. **Amendment No. 3 (MH120488) with Topanga-Roscoe Corporation dba Topanga West Guest Home** revises language under Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and adds new provisions to the Agreement pursuant to the new Ordinance No. 2009-0026 (Los Angeles County Code 2.206, Defaulted Property Tax Reduction Program), and also adds Cash Flow Advances (CFAs) for up to 1/12th of the MCA per month, for up to four (4) additional months.
8. **Amendment No. 4 (MH120495) with Alcott Center for Mental Health Services** shifts funds from MHSA Urgent Care Centers Medi-Cal/Healthy Families (HF) to MHSA Urgent Care Centers non-Medi-Cal/Indigent by \$51,956. There is no change to the MCA.
9. **Amendment No. 7 (MH120542) with St. Joseph Center** decreases Homeless non-Medi-Cal/Indigent by \$11,523 and increases Homeless Medi-Cal/HF by \$30,000, with a revised MCA of \$1,165,375.
10. **Amendment No. 5 (MH120555) with VIP Community Mental Health Center, Inc.**, decreases Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) Medical Hub non-Medi-Cal/Indigent by \$107,466 and increases Specialized Foster Care Medi-Cal/HF by \$2,168,665, with a revised MCA of \$5,880,100.

The following two (2) amendments to LE Agreements (11 and 12) increase or decrease General Relief Opportunities For Work (GROW) funds:
