SUBJECT: **AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 51 Amendments to existing Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), and Clinical Assessment programs processed in the month of December 2008, as follows:

- Amendment No. 10 (MH010054) with The Regents of the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA)** intends to amend Agreement to add a new Addendum G (Development of a Disaster Mental Health Model; Concept of Operations; and Coordinated Incident Management Strategy and Training) fully funded by grant funds from the Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$650,000.
- Amendment No. 1 (MH050020) with Karen Bollow** extends the term of this Agreement for a period of 12 months on a month-to-month basis, beginning January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2009, to continue services pertaining to implementation of an Integrated Behavioral Health Information System. There will be no change to the Total Compensation Amount.
- Amendment No. 24 (MH120144) with Pacific Clinics** intends to shift Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Adult Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS) Mental Health Services (MHS) funds that were inadvertently allocated under Child FCCS MHS. The shift will be as follows: FCCS Child one-time funds in the amount of \$61,700; FCCS Child Client Supportive Services (CSS) in the amount of \$20,000; FCCS Child MHS in the amount of \$2,622,381; and Non-Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) in the amount of \$318,350 will be shifted to Adult FCCS MHS in the amount of \$2,422,381; Older Adult FCCS MHS in the amount of \$261,700; Older Adult FCCS CSS in the amount of \$20,000; and Non-EPSDT in the amount of \$318,350. The Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) will be \$78,265,076.

4. **Amendment No. 18 (MH120174) with San Fernando Valley Community Mental Health Center (SFVCMHC)** intends to change the provider name from SFVCMHC/Victory Partners located at 14530 Hamlin Street, Van Nuys, CA 91400 to SFVCMHC/Adult FCCS (the Provider Number (PN) 7252 will remain the same) and also changes provider name from SFVCMHC/Victory Clubhouse located at 14411 Vanowen Street, Van Nuys, CA 91411 to SFVCMHC/Victory Wellness Center (the PN 7235 will also remain the same). There will be no change to the MCA.
5. **Amendment No. 3 (MH120274) with Topanga-Roscoe Corporation dba Topanga West Guest Home** revises Paragraph 10 (PERFORMANCE STANDARDS AND OUTCOME MEASURES) to include a reference to "Performance Standards and Outcome Measure Exhibit" (Exhibit X), adds Paragraph 62 (LOCAL SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PREFERENCE PROGRAM), and revises the "Safely Surrendered Baby Law Program" handout and fact sheet. There will be no change to the MCA.

The following two (2) amendments to LE Agreements (6 and 7) add a new delivery site location and new PN to be announced. Provided at these sites are Targeted Case Management Services (TCMS) (Mode 15, Service Function Codes (SFCs) 01-09), MHS (Mode 15, SFCs 10-19/30-59), Medication Support Services (Mode 15, SFCs 60-69), Crisis Intervention (Mode 15, SFCs 70-79), and Support Services – CSS (Mode 60, SFCs 64/70-79):

6. **Amendment No. 14 (MH120173) with Providence Community Services, LLC.**, adds a new service delivery site located at 1008 West Avenue J-10, Lancaster, CA 93534. There will be no change to the MCA.
7. **Amendment No. 8 (MH120222) with Foothill Family Service** adds a new service delivery site identified as Foothill Family Service – Duarte at 1801 Huntington Drive, Duarte, CA 91010. There will be no change to the MCA.

The following two (2) amendments to LE Agreements (8 and 9) intend to use Title IV E Waiver funds to match the EPSDT funds to continue to provide the Functional Family Therapy MHS to Seriously Emotionally Disturbed juvenile offenders started under the Mentally Ill Offenders Crime Reduction Program. Waiver Funds will be provided by Los Angeles County Probation Department:

8. **Amendment No. 10 (MH120253) with SHIELDS For Families** adds \$64,685 in Title IV E waiver matching funds, \$410,246 in EPSDT State General Funds

(SGF) and \$474,932 in EPSDT Federal Financial Participation (FFP) funds for a total increase of \$949,863. The revised MCA will be \$7,634,164.

9. **Amendment No. 15 (MH120261) with Star View Adolescent Center, Inc.,** adds \$29,136 in Title IV E waiver matching funds, \$184,785 in EPSDT-SGF, and \$213,921 in EPSDT-FFP funds for a total increase of \$427,842. The revised MCA will be \$26,813,541.

The following three (3) amendments to LE Agreements (10 to 12) extend the term of this Agreement for a second six (6) month extension, beginning January 1, 2009, through June 30, 2009, with a provision for two one (1) year renewal periods.
