SUBJECT: **AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of seven (7) Amendments to existing Legal Entity (LE) Agreements processed in the month of March 2009, as follows:

- Amendment No. 12 (MH120253) with SHIELDS For Families** changes the service delivery site from 12714 South Avalon, Suite 300, Los Angeles, CA 90061 to 11601 South Western Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90047, Provider Number (PN) To Be Determined (TBD); and also adds new service delivery sites at 2620 Industry Way, Suite A, Lynwood, CA 90262 and at 3209 North Alameda, Suite D, Lynwood, CA 90262, under PN 7365. There is no change to the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA).
- Amendment No. 1 (MH120297) with FamiliesFirst, Inc.**, adds language to ensure that FamiliesFirst, Inc., is responsible for all duties and obligations of Eastfield Ming Quong, Inc., dba EMQ Child and Family Services (EMQ), which merged into FamiliesFirst, Inc., effective January 1, 2009. There is no change to the MCA.
- Amendment No. 1 (MH120322) with Braswell Rehabilitation Institute for Development of Growth and Education Services, Inc.**, adds the following Provisional Rates under Cost Reimbursement for Outpatient Services, Medication Support (Mode 15, Service Function Codes (SFCs) 60-69) at a rate of \$3.75, under Medi-Cal/Short-Doyle PN 7595. There is no change to the MCA.
- Amendment No. 1 (MH120333) with Clontarf Manor, Inc.**, increases non-Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (non-EPSTD) Federal Financial Participation (FFP) by \$50 and non-EPSTD County General Fund (CGF) match by \$3; decreases Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Transition Age Youth (TAY) Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS) Client Supportive Services (CSS) and Mental Health Services (MHS) by \$300 and \$4,700,

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respectively, and decreases MHSA TAY FCCS non-EPSTD by \$4,950; increases MHSA Adult FCCS CSS and MHS by \$1,049 and \$16,551, respectively, and increases MHSA Adult non-EPSTD by \$17,097; decreases MHSA Older Adult FCCS CSS and MHS by \$800 and \$11,800, respectively, and decreases MHSA Older Adult non-EPSTD by \$12,100. The revised MCA will be \$1,012,100.

5. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120355) with Hamburger Home dba Aviva Family and Children's Services dba Aviva Center** adds Case Management Support (Mode 60, SFCs 60-69) at a rate of \$80 to existing PN 7626 located at 6400 Laurel Canyon Blvd., Suite 230, North Hollywood, CA 91606. There is no change to the MCA.
6. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120381) with Pacific Clinics** intends to shift MHSA Adult FCCS MHS funds to MHSA Wellness Centers in the amount of \$700,000. There is no change to the MCA.
7. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120404) with The Guidance Center** adds a 5th Floor and a site name to current service delivery site from 3711 Long Beach Blvd., Suite 600, Long Beach, CA 90807 to The Guidance Center – Hinchman House, 3711 Long Beach Blvd., 5th and 6th Floors, Long Beach, CA 90807, under existing Medi-Cal/Short-Doyle PN 7433. The services to be provided at this site are Targeted Case Management Services (Mode 15, SFCs 01-09), MHS (Mode 15, SFCs 10-19/30-59), Medication Support (Mode 15, SFCs 60-69), Crisis Intervention (Mode 15, SFCs 70-79), Therapeutic Behavioral Services (Mode 15, SFC 58), Mental Health Promotion (Mode 45, SFCs 10-19), Community Client Services (Mode 45, SFCs 20-29), and Case Management Support (Mode 60, SFCs 60-69). There is no change to the MCA.
