SUBJECT: **AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 118 amendments to existing Legal Entity Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Pharmacy Agreements, Community Care Residential Facility Agreements, and Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers) processed in the month of April, as follows:

1. **Amendment No. 1 (Synopsis #77) with CompHealth Associates, Inc.**, clarifies the understanding between Contractor and County of their obligations with respect to candidates who have been identified as physicians hired before June 30, 2003 by the Department of Mental Health (DMH), given that the contract term will not be extended after March 18, 2003.
2. **Amendment No. 3 (DMH-00900) with California Mental Health Directors Association (CMHDA)**, increases the Maximum Contract Amount by \$137,500 in Realignment funds to provide additional consultation services for specialized technical mental health knowledge related to strategic, organizational, and systems planning. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for Fiscal Year (FY) 2002-2003 is \$248,500.
3. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01187) with Children's Hospital of Los Angeles**, changes the Negotiated Rates for FY 2002-2003 for Mode 10, Service Function Codes (SFC) 95-99, from \$115.25 to \$115.14, and Mode 15, SFCs 60-69, from \$4.24 to \$4.23.
4. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01189) with The Church Home Children of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Los Angeles dba Hillside Home for Children**, reduces \$379,639 of Federal Financial Participation (FFP)

funds and \$431,210 of Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) funds for FY 2002-2003. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for FY 2002-2003 is \$7,492,580.

5. **Amendment No. 1 (DMH-01191) with Clontarf Manor**, adds \$80,000 in Realignment funds for client support activities that were redirected due to the termination of the Supplemental Rate Program. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for FY 2002-2003 is \$781,361.
6. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01191) with Clontarf Manor**, changes the Negotiated Rates for FY 2002-2003 for Mode 10, SFCs 91-94, from \$73.84 to \$73.77, and Mode 15, SFCs 60-69, from \$4.24 to \$4.23. There is no change to the Maximum Contract Amount.
7. **Amendment No. 5 (DMH-01195) with Didi Hirsch Psychiatric Service**, adds Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) Family Preservation funds in the amount of \$4,650 for FY 2002-2003. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for FY 2002-2003 is \$15,813,928.
8. **Amendment No. 7 (DMH-01203) with ENKI Health and Research Systems, Inc.**, changes the Negotiated Rates for FY 2002-2003 for Mode 10, SFCs 85-89, from \$119.28 to \$119.16, and SFCs 95-99, from \$67.30 to \$67.23.
9. **Amendment No. 1 (DMH-01220) with Health View, Inc. dba Harbor View House**, changes the Negotiated Rate for FY 2002-2003 for Mode 10, SFCs 91-94, from \$63.71 to \$55.40.
10. **Amendment No. 4 (DMH-01226) with Kedren Community Health Center**, shifts \$49,219 in ATCMS funds and \$308,261 in ISA/Partners funds to ACT Services of \$332,480 and ACT Client Supportive Services of \$25,000 and reduces the Maximum Contract Amount by \$83,855 in County General Funds (CGF) for FY 2002-2003. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for FY 2002-2003 is \$18,369,140.
11. **Amendment No. 8 (DMH-01241) with Mental Health Association in Los Angeles County (MHA)**, removes State Integrated Service Agency (ISA) funds in the amount of \$1,696,347 for FYs 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 to reflect an adjustment due to the State elimination of Assembly Bill (AB) 3777 funding for the ISA programs; decreases CGF in the amount of \$58,492 to transfer funds used under capitation for acute hospital and Institute for Mental Diseases costs

to DMH for FY 2002-2003; adds one-time AB 2034 Program funds allocated by the State DMH in the amount of \$1,500,000 for FY 2002-2003; and decreases CGF in the amount of \$233,967 to reflect an adjustment due to the reduction in the CGF allocation for FY 2003-2004.

12. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01252) with PROTOTYPES (I-Can)**, changes the Negotiated Rates for FY 2002-2003 for Mode 10, SFCs 91-94, from \$52.79 to \$52.74, and 95-99, from \$83.28 to \$83.20.
13. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01253) with Research and Treatment Institute, Inc.**, changes the Negotiated Rate for FY 2002-2003 for Mode 10, SFCs 95-99, from \$99.22 to \$99.13. The Maximum Contract Amount remains the same at \$1,946,364 for FY 2002-2003.
14. **Amendment No. 5 (DMH-01260) with Special Service for Groups**, adds AB 2034 Program funds in the amount of \$79,417 and \$5,598 in CGF to the Maximum Contract Amount for direct mental health services for FY 2002-2003.
15. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01275) with Verdugo Mental Health Center**, converts \$8,958 from AB 2034 funds to CGF funds for FY 2002-2003.
16. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01277) with Watts Labor Community Action Committee**, changes the Negotiated Rate for FYs 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 for Mode 15, SFCs 01-09, from \$1.54 to \$1.77. The Maximum Contract Amount remains the same at \$267,418 for FY 2002-2003.
