SUBJECT: **AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 650 amendments to existing Legal Entity Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Pharmacy Agreement, and Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers) processed in the month of February 2004, as follows:

1. **Amendment No. 1 (DMH-01407) with California Institute for Mental Health (CIMH)**, adds \$200,000 to the Maximum Contract Amount for Fiscal Years (FY) 2003-2004, 2004-2005, and 2005-2006 to allow CIMH to conduct three separate studies on supportive services to Los Angeles County's Welfare-to-Work efforts and examine program results, measure performance, identify outcomes, and present recommendations. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for FYs 2003-2004, 2004-2005, and 2005-2006 is \$220,000.
2. **Amendment No. 4 (DMH-01435) with ASC Treatment Group dba The Anne Sippi Clinic**, adds County General Funds (CGF) in the amount of \$81,200 to fund the increased number of treatment beds for the residential mental health treatment program for FY 2003-2004. The revised Maximum Contract Amount for FY 2003-2004 is \$490,573.
3. **Amendment No. 3 (DMH-01447) with Didi Hirsch Psychiatric Service**, implements a technical adjustment to the CGF by decreasing \$60,316 for FYs 2003-2004, 2004-2005, and 2005-2006; decreasing CGF in the amount of \$302,630; increasing FFP Medi-Cal funds in the total amount of \$398,995; and decreasing EPSDT – SGF in the amount of \$213,700 for FY 2003-2004 only. The revised Maximum Contract Amount FY 2003-2004 is \$16,246,729.

4. **Amendment No. 5 (DMH-01455) with Gateways Hospital and Mental Health Center**, adds \$50,000 to the Maximum Contract Amount in one-time only Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Rollover funds for the Crisis Drop-in and Emergency Shelter program at 340 North Madison Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90004, for FY 2003-2004 only.
5. **Amendment No. 3 (DMH-01474) with Olive Crest Treatment Center Inc. dba Olive Crest**, decreases CGF in the amount of \$1,959; increases FFP Medi-Cal funds in the total amount of \$31,481; and decreases EPSDT – SGF in the amount of \$31,400 for FY 2003-2004 only.
6. **Amendment No. 3 (DMH-01490) with Verdugo Mental Health Center**, decreases CGF in the amount of \$50,000; decreases FFP Medi-Cal funds in the total amount of \$186,550; decreases EPSDT – SGF in the amount of \$163,450; and decreases CalWORKs in the amount of \$150,000 in order to transfer these funds to a newly created DMH – Legal Entity Agreement with the Institute for Multicultural Counseling & Education Services, Inc. (I.M.C.E.S.) for FY 2003-2004 only.
7. **Amendment No. 1 (DMH-01504) with City of Gardena**, changes the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) language due to certain changes in the Information Systems (IS) of DMH and further clarifies the IS terminology for FYs 2003-2004, 2004-2005, and 2005-2006.
8. **Amendment No. 2 (DMH-01504) with City of Gardena**, decreases CGF in the amount of \$2,357 for FY 2003-2004 only.
9. **Amendment No. 6 (DMH-01508) with Devereux Foundation dba Devereux Santa Barbara dba Devereux California**, decreases FFP Medi-Cal funds in the amount of \$27,791 and EPSDT – SGF in the amount of \$24,350 for FY 2003-2004 only.
10. **Amendment No. 4 (DMH-01519) with Heritage Clinic and The Community Assistance Program For Seniors dba Geronet**, adds CGF in the amount of \$12,681 for FY 2003-2004 to provide mental health care services.
11. **Amendment No. 5 (DMH-01529) with Mental Health Association in Los Angeles County**, adds one-time only United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Grant funds from the City of Hawthorne in the amount of

\$106,863 for FY 2003-2004 for the provision of mental health services to Section 8 tenants.

12. **Amendment No. 6 (DMH-01529) with Mental Health Association in Los Angeles County**, adds \$1,000,000 in ongoing SAMHSA funds; adds \$500,000 in one-time only CGF; and decreases \$750,000 in ongoing CGF for FY 2003-2004. The funding changes and shift had to do with the deletion of AB 3777 funds from the State's budget and the intent to then maintain MHA's Village services at its current level.

This new rate includes the Special Treatment Program (STP) patch rate of \$5.72, which remains the same per client/per day as last year.
