SUBJECT: **AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 382 amendments to existing Legal Entity Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Pharmacy Agreements, Community Care Residential Facility Agreements, Medi-Cal Psychiatric Inpatient Hospital Services Agreements, and Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers) processed in the month of September, as follows:

1. **Amendment No. 2 between the Department of Mental Health (DMH) and Community Development Commission (Commission) – Cedar Street Homes for Development Consultant Services**, adds \$95,000 in Realignment funds to the contract with the Commission for continued provision of project management and services, including, but not limited to, Commission loan consultant services for Fiscal Year (FY) 2003-2004.
