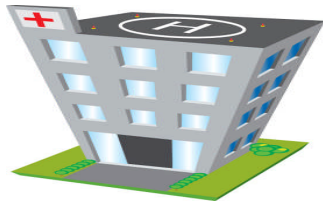

SHORT-DOYLE/MEDI-CAL PHASE II: NEW EMERGENCY SERVICES INDICATOR

With the implementation of Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal Phase II, the State Department of Mental Health is now requiring information about services provided to a Medi-Cal beneficiary with a restricted aid code specific to emergency services. If the client has an Emergency Services or Emergency/Pregnancy Related Services restricted Medi-Cal Aid Code and the service provided was a crisis intervention, crisis stabilization, or emergency medication support, then check the new emergency check box on the Integrated System (IS) Outpatient Claim screen as shown below. Providers must run an eligibility check to verify if the client has a restricted emergency aid code before checking the emergency check box. The Medi-Cal Aid Codes Manual can be found at:
