



Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) Release Notes

Release Update – 2024.2

June 6, 2024

This release includes the following updates:

- Contracted Providers will now be able to search for clients at all ages, allowing them to view and edit previously entered assessments after clients turned 21 years old.
- The Portal will now only save and display the "Administrative Close Reason" when "Assessment Type" is "Administrative Close".
- The system now captures the user who created and modified the PSC assessments via model-driven app (MDA) and Portal in the same "Created By" and "Modified By" custom fields.
- The system now captures the user who created and modified the CANS assessments via MDA and Portal in the same "Created By" and "Modified By" custom fields.

- Added functionality to allow contract providers to submit the new PSC and CANS "Urgent" and "Administrative Close" assessments.
- Added new "Administrative close reason" field to capture the reason for the "Administrative close" assessment.

- Enabled Azure Active Directory authentication so that contracted providers can use their existing Active Directory credentials to access the application.
- Replaced the [Provider Number] free text field with drop-down list to foster data integrity.
- Replaced the [Practitioner] free text field with drop-down list to foster data integrity.

Pediatric Symptom Checklist (PSC-35)

- Ability to add, update, deactivate, and view a Reassessment and Discharge assessment.

- Ability to indicate caregiver did not respond to all required questions.
- Ability to indicate "Not Applicable" for school related questions.
- Ability to have up to three unanswered questions.
- Removed the "Has Caregiver" data element.

- Ability to add, update, deactivate, and view a Reassessment and Discharge assessment.
- Ability to capture trauma and risk questions.
- Ability to capture additional caregiver resources and needs.
- Ability to capture contributor's names and relationships.
