AW has been performing workforce development services for vulnerable populations for thirty-six (36) years, helping over one million individuals become employed. AW's client base encompasses a variety of low-income vulnerable populations, including youth and justice-involved individuals. In addition to serving Los Angeles, AW has offices in twelve (12) states plus the District of Columbia.

AW has provided workforce services to justice-involved individuals in seven (7) states, and has helped over 150,000 justice-involved individuals start new careers. Additionally, AW has a history of providing technical assistance to agencies in need and assisting them in recruiting, hiring, and training their staff in AW's proven model of service.

The organization's experience serving Youth is varied in terms of size and location, but consistent in demonstrated success. AW provides workforce services to over 3,000 youth per year, with recent experience serving youth in New York, New Jersey, and Tennessee. AW offers youth programming designed to be engaging and valuable, with events that inform and inspire while helping youth gain the connections they need to get ahead.

In California, AWCA has offices in San Francisco, Fresno, and Los Angeles, serving individuals with disabilities, justice-involved individuals, and homeless veterans. It's Los Angeles location currently has two programs:

- ❖ Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP): AWCA provides veterans who are homeless or at risk of homelessness with job-driven employment, training, and supportive services;
- ❖ Ticket To Work (TTW): AWCA offers recruitment, assessments, in-demand sector-specific trainings, job readiness, job placement and intensive case management services to SSI/SSDI beneficiaries.
